It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 22-7.4 of the General Laws entitled "Permanent Joint Committee
- 2 on Naming All New Buildings, Bridges, Edifices and Other State Constructions" is hereby
- 3 amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 4 <u>22-7.4-111. The Thomas C. Slater Training School. -- The facility known as the Rhode</u>
- 5 Island Training School in the city of Cranston, consisting of the Roosevelt Benton Youth
- 6 Assessment Center, a youth development center, and a female unit, shall hereafter be named and
- 7 known as "The Thomas C. Slater Training School" in honor of Rhode Island State Representative
- 8 Thomas C. Slater in recognition of his many and varied contributions to the facility and the State
- 9 of Rhode Island.

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SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
