CONGRATULATING BREEZE PUBLICATIONS OWNERS THOMAS V. WARD AND JAMES QUINN ON THE TENTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE NORTH SMITHFIELD AND WOONSOCKET VALLEY BREEZE

1 WHEREAS, The birth of The Valley Breeze Newspapers occurred thirteen years ago in 2 Thomas Ward's living room in Cumberland when he and James Quinn published the 3 Cumberland/Lincoln edition; and WHEREAS, Three years later, the North Smithfield/Woonsocket edition began covering 4 5 news, events, and advertising. It began with a publication of twelve thousand copies within the two towns, and has expanded to its current circulation of over sixteen thousand; and 6 7 WHEREAS, The mission of the Valley Breeze Newspapers is to "facilitate a positive sense of community among the residents of Northern Rhode Island by providing a forum for the 8 9 free exchange of ideas, and to provide information of local events and neighbors"; and 10 WHEREAS, As co-owner and founding father of Breeze Publication, Inc., Thomas Ward 11 is active in the community. In addition to serving as publisher to the papers, he is a member of the 12 Cumberland/Lincoln Rotary, where he served as President in 2007. He is also a member of the 13 Board of Directors of the Northern Rhode Island Chamber of Commerce, a member of the Board of Directors for the Rhode Island Catholic (formerly the Providence Visitor), and has sponsored 14 15 the Rhode Island Spelling Bee for the past three years; and 16 WHEREAS, James Quinn, co-owner and also one of the founding fathers of Breeze 17 Publications, Inc., serves as Deputy Publisher of the papers. He has demonstrated his 18 commitment not only to his profession, but also to the communities of Woonsocket and North

Smithfield, through his insightful guidance and dedication to regional reporting; and
