- 3 <u>46-22-13.2. Bridge safety. All ships over one hundred fifty feet (150') in length whose</u>
- 4 primary cargo is hazardous material shall have at least twenty-five feet (25') of clearance under
- 5 all of Rhode Island's bridges. This section shall not apply to boats under sail.
- 6 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
