RELATING TO MOTOR AND OTHER VEHICLES - NOISE LIMITS FOR MOTOR VEHICLES

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 31-45-1 of the General Laws in Chapter 31-45 entitled "Noise

2 Limits for Motor Vehicles" is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 31-45-1. Noise limits. -- (a) No person shall operate a motor vehicle, nor shall the owner

4 of any vehicle allow the vehicle to be operated, at any time, or under any condition of grade, load,

5 acceleration, or deceleration, in such a manner as to exceed the following noise limit based on the

6 idle test procedure in accordance with the Society of Automotive Engineers ("S.A.E.") Standard

7 J2825 issued May, 2009. a distance of fifty feet (50') from the center of the lane of travel within

the speed limit. For the purposes of this section, "dbA" means decibels measured with a

calibrated sound level meter weighted to the "A" scale.

10 (b) In speed zones of thirty-five miles per hour (35 mph) or less, not more than eighty-

11 six (86) dbA. In speed zones of more than thirty five miles per hour (35 mph), not more than

ninety (90) dbA. No motor vehicle shall exceed ninety-two (92) dbA at idle when measured in

accordance with S.A.E. Standard J2825.

(c) Violations of this section are subject to fines enumerated in section 31-41.1-4.

15 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
