It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 11-47-35.1 of the General Laws in Chapter 11-47 entitled
"Weapons" is hereby amended to read as follows:

- <u>11-47-35.1. Persons exempt from section 11-47-35. --</u> The provisions of section 11-47-35 shall not apply to full-time members of the state police, full-time members of the state marshal's office, full-time members of city or town police departments, or state marshals or correctional officers or persons licensed under <u>sections</u> 11-47-11. or 11-47-18, or any person who has been issued a protective order pursuant to chapter 15-15 or chapter 8-8.1 of the Rhode Island general laws.
- 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
