It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 23-4.7 of the General Laws entitled "Informed Consent for
2	Abortion" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following sections:
3	23-4.7-1.1. "Forced and required" defined For the purposes of this chapter, the
4	terms "forced and required" shall mean being coerced, pressured, threatened, physically,
5	emotionally, psychologically or otherwise, including the loss of employment or any social
6	assistance of any type in which such pregnant woman is already participating, harassed or
7	ordered by any agency or department of the State of Rhode Island or any employee thereof.
8	23-4.7-9. Civil action for abortion against women's will Any woman who is forced
9	or required to have an abortion against her will and without her free consent, shall be entitled to
10	bring a civil action for torturous conduct against the person, persons or state agency or any
11	subdivision thereof who forced or required her to have an abortion in contravention of this
12	chapter within three (3) years of her eighteenth birthday or within three (3) years of the date of
13	the abortion if the woman is more than eighteen (18) years of age at the time of the abortion. In
14	addition to the action for herself, the woman shall have a right of action for wrongful death of the
15	unborn child against the person, persons, agencies, departments, whether private or public, who
16	forced or required her to have an abortion

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
