It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 20-14 of the General Laws entitled "Birds" is hereby amended by
- 2 adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>20-14-8.2. West shore of the Providence River. No person shall take, kill, destroy, or</u>
- 4 pursue or in any manner molest any wild bird in that part of the cities of Warwick and Cranston
- 5 on the west shore of that portion of upper Narragansett Bay, which is also known as the
- 6 Providence River, from Gaspee Point to Fields Point or within one thousand feet (1,000') of the
- 7 west shore or banks of the Providence River from Gaspee Point to Fields Point.
- 8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
