It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 31-22.1-1 of the General Laws in Chapter 31-22.1 entitled "Pupil

Transportation Vehicles" is hereby amended to read as follows:

31-22.1-1. Pupil transportation vehicle — Definition.

4 A pupil transportation vehicle is a motor vehicle designed and constructed to seat not more

5 than eight (8) ten (10) passengers including the operator, used by a school committee to provide

the transportation services required by law or regulation to students being conveyed along a fixed

school transportation route. In particular, such vehicles may be used to provide the transportation

services required by § 16-21-1, § 16-21.1-1, et seq., and § 16-24-4 on routes in which only small

numbers of students are being conveyed.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
