SECTION 1. Effective upon the passage of this act, the Town of Westerly is relieved

paid by the state.

SECTION 2. Upon the implementation of any program change permitted under section 1

6 hereof, the chairperson of the Westerly school committee shall provide to the department of

7 education, and the department of administration of the Town of Westerly shall provide to the

office of municipal affairs (administration/planning), certification that any such program changes

9 have no adverse effect on public health or safety.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage.
