It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 35-4-27 of the General Laws in Chapter 35-4 entitled "State Funds" 2 is hereby amended to read as follows: 3 35-4-27. Indirect cost recoveries on restricted receipt accounts. - Indirect cost 4 recoveries of ten percent (10%) of cash receipts shall be transferred from all restricted receipt 5 accounts, to be recorded as general revenues in the general fund. However, there shall be no transfer from cash receipts with restrictions received exclusively: (1) from contributions from 6 7 non-profit charitable organizations; (2) from the assessment of indirect cost recovery rates on federal grant funds; or (3) through transfers from state agencies to the department of 8 9 administration for the payment of debt service. These indirect cost recoveries shall be applied to all accounts, unless prohibited by federal law or regulation, court order, or court settlement. The 10 11 following restricted receipt accounts shall not be subject to the provisions of this section: 12 **Executive Office of Health and Human Services** 13 Organ Transplant Fund 14 **HIV Care Grant Drug Rebates** 15 Department of Human Services Veterans' home - Restricted account

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EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

This act would exempt specified restricted receipt accounts from the ten percent (10%)
indirect cost recovery charge.

The provision relating to the Job Development Fund would take effect on July 1, 2014,
notwithstanding the provision of Article 3, Section 4 of 2014 H-7133 Substitute A, entitled "AN
ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE SUPPORT OF THE STATE FOR THE FISCAL
YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2015." The remainder of the act would take effect on January 1,
2014.
