It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 34-18 of the General Laws entitled "Residential Landlord and
 Tenant Act" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>34-18-58. Inquiries regarding immigration status. (a) No landlord or any agent of</u>
- 4 <u>the landlord shall:</u>
- 5 (1) Make any inquiry regarding or based on the immigration or citizenship status of a
- 6 <u>tenant, prospective tenant, occupant, or prospective occupant of residential rental property; or</u>
- 7 (2) Require that any tenant, prospective tenant, occupant, or prospective occupant of the
- 8 rental property make any statement, representation, or certification concerning his or her
- 9 <u>immigration or citizenship status.</u>
- 10 (b) No municipality or housing agency shall compel a landlord or any agent of the

11 landlord to make any inquiry, compile, disclose, report, or provide any information, prohibit

- 12 offering or continuing to offer, accommodations in the property for rent or lease, or otherwise
- 13 take any action regarding or based on the immigration or citizenship status of a tenant,
- 14 prospective tenant, occupant or prospective occupant of residential rental property.
- 15 (c) Nothing in this section shall prohibit a landlord from:
- 16 (1) Complying with any legal obligation under federal law; or
- 17 (2) Requesting information or documentation necessary to determine or verify the
- 18 financial qualifications of a prospective tenant, or to determine or verify the identity of a
- 19 prospective tenant or prospective occupant.
