It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 31-37-16.2 of the General Laws in Chapter 31-37 entitled "Retail
- 2 Sale of Gasoline" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 31-37-16.2. Air pumps. -- (a) Every retail dealer shall display and maintain a
- 4 compressed air pump which shall be available during the hours the business is open, at no cost to
- 5 the consumer, whether the business is an attended or self service gas station. The division of
- 6 motor vehicles of motor vehicles, safety and emission control unit, shall be responsible for the
- 7 enforcement of this section and the bringing of complaints under section 31-37-17.
- 8 (b) The provisions of section 31-37-18 shall apply to the division of motor vehicles, and
- 9 any of its agents in the enforcement of this section.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
