It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 16-2 of the General Laws entitled "School Committees and

Superintendents" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

3 <u>16-2-28.3. Kindergarten -- Hours of instruction -- School day. -- Notwithstanding any</u>

4 provisions of the general or public laws or rule or regulation to the contrary, a kindergarten

5 school day must contain at least five and one half (5 ½) hours (three hundred thirty (330)

6 minutes) of actual school work excluding lunch, recess periods, common planning time, pre and

7 post school teacher time, study halls, homeroom periods, student passing time and any other time

8 that is not actual instructional time. Student advisory periods may be counted as instructional

time. The commissioner has discretion to decide whether other school programs may be counted

as instructional time.
