Participants were evaluated in the areas of Scholastics, 8 Interview, Talent, Fitness, and Self-Expression; and 9 WHEREAS, Viansi plans to major in political science at the University of Alabama, 10 where she has earned a four-year renewable, full-tuition scholarship from the Distinguished 11 Young Women program.
