#### RELATING TO CRIMINAL OFFENSES - FRAUD AND FALSE DEALING

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 11-18 of the General Laws entitled "Fraud and False Dealing" is
- 2 hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>11-18-1.3. False statement to obtain license or registration. --</u> <u>Any person who shall</u>
- 4 knowingly and intentionally prepare, file or cause to be filed with the division of motor vehicles,
- 5 or any employee or agent of the division of motor vehicles, any application, statement or affidavit
- 6 in writing which is false or erroneous, or defective in any important particular, and which, to his
- 7 or her knowledge, is intended to induce or cause the department or its employees or agents, to
- 8 issue a registration or license, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be
- 9 punished by imprisonment for not more than one year, or by a fine of not more than one thousand
- 10 <u>dollars (\$1,000), or both.</u>

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11 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

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1 This act would provide that any person who furnishes a false statement in order to obtain a driver's license or registration would be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction would be 2 3 punished by imprisonment for not more than one year or by a fine of not more than one thousand 4 dollars (\$1,000), or both. 5 This act would take effect upon passage.

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
