RELATING TO INSURANCE - HEALTH INSURANCE - COPAYMENTS

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 27-18 of the General Laws entitled "Accident and Sickness

Insurance Policies" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

27-18-70. Ambulance co-payments. -- Any ambulance co-payment or deductible in 3

excess of fifty dollars (\$50.00) due from the patient and billed to the patient by any licensed

5 ambulance service provider and not collected by the ambulance provider from the patient within

ninety (90) days of being billed to the patient shall be billed back to the patient's medical 6

7 insurance company. The insurance company shall then reimburse the licensed ambulance service

any amount due in excess of fifty dollars (\$50.00) for any co-payment or deductible amount due 8

9 within thirty (30) days.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

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EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

RELATING TO INSURANCE - HEALTH INSURANCE - COPAYMENTS

This act would require that health insurance companies pay bills for ambulance copays or deductibles in excess of fifty dollars (\$50.00) if the patient has not paid the bill within ninety (90) days.

This act would take effect upon passage.

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
