It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 37-13-3.1 of the General Laws in Chapter 37-13 entitled "Labor

and Payment of Debts by Contractors" is hereby amended to read as follows:

37-13-3.1. State public works contract apprenticeship requirements. Public works

4 contract apprenticeship requirements. -- (a) Notwithstanding any laws to the contrary, prior to

5 bidding on all public works construction projects valued at one million dollars (\$1,000,000) or

more, all general contractors and subcontractors who perform work on any public works contract 6

7 awarded by the state after passage of this act and valued at one million dollars (\$1,000,000) or

more shall employ apprentices required for the performance of the awarded contract have an 8

approved indentured apprentice program with the Rhode Island department of labor and training

for all licensed and unlicensed work to be performed. The number of apprentices shall comply 10

with the apprentice to journeyman ratio for each trade approved by the apprenticeship council of

12 the department of labor and training.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage on January 1, 2011.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC PROPERTY AND WORKS

This act would provide that prior to bidding on public works projects valued at \$1,000,000 or more, all general contractors and subcontractors shall have an approved indentured apprenticeship program with the department of labor and training.

This act would take effect on January 1, 2011.
