It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 22-11 of the General Laws entitled "Joint Committee on
2 Legislative Services" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

3 **22-11-3.6. General assembly member health insurance benefits. – Senators and**
4 **representatives of the general assembly shall pay a share of their health insurance benefits equal**
5 **to a minimum of fifteen percent (15%) of the cost of said benefits. Further, no senator or**
6 **representative who receives a similar taxpayer funded health care benefit from the state or any**
7 **subdivision thereof, or from any municipality of the state, shall be paid a state subsidy or**
8 **emolument or waiver in lieu of his or her refusal to accept the state health care benefit.**

9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect the first Tuesday in January of the year 2014.

1 This act would require senators and representatives to pay a share for their health
2 insurance benefits equal to a minimum of fifteen percent (15%) of the cost of benefits and would
3 prohibit any payment or state subsidy for waiving said health insurance benefits.

4 This act would take effect the first Tuesday in January of the year 2014.

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
