It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

| 3 | 37-2-80. Construction job site safety responsibility (a) All construction projects |
| 4 | with a total cost of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) or more which involve any Rhode |
| 5 | Island public agency shall contain provisions for the design and administration of job-site safety |
| 6 | programs separate and autonomous from the general contract. The job-site safety contractor's |
| 7 | function shall be to assure that construction safety standards as developed and recognized by |
| 8 | OSHA are adhered to throughout the course of the construction project. |
| 9 | (b) Any company designing and maintaining the job-site safety program must be licensed |
| 10 | by the state to engage in such work, and must contract with the public agency involved. |
| 11 | Companies licensed to perform the functions of designing and administering job-site safety |
| 12 | programs shall be independent from any company licensed to bid on construction projects in this |
| 13 | state. |
| 14 | (c) The director of the department of labor and training shall promulgate rules and |
| 15 | regulations and penalties to enforce the provisions of this section. |
| 16 | SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage. |
