- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 40.1-8.5 of the General Laws entitled "Community Mental Health
- 2 Services" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 40.1-8.5-8. Suicide prevention and mental health crisis 9-8-8 hotline.
- The sum of one million eight hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$1,875,000) of federal 4
- 5 funds contained in the state fiscal recovery fund shall be appropriated for the creation of a 9-8-8
- hotline to maintain compliance with the National Suicide Hotline Designation Act of 2020 and the 6
- 7 Federal Communications Commission-adopted rules to assure that all citizens receive a consistent
- 8 level of 9-8-8 and crisis behavioral health services.
- 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
