It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

3	23-18.11-3. Prohibited practices No retail establishment located and doing business
4	within the state shall sell or convey goods, food, or goods which have been the subject matter of
5	the rendering of personal services thereon, directly to the ultimate consumers within the state in
6	plastic bags, unless the retailer makes available to each consumer a paper bag as an option at no
7	greater charge than the plastic bag. The retailer must advertise clearly the availability of this
8	option. Any retailer who chooses to transfer purchases in paper bags only, need not make other
9	optional bags available any checkout bags other than the following: recyclable paper bags, and/or
10	compostable plastic bags, and/or reusable bags.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on January 1, 2011.
