It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 411-4 of the General Laws in Chapter 411 entitled "Psittacine
- 2 Birds" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 <u>4-11-4. Banding of birds imported, sold, or given. --</u> All psittacine birds imported,
- 4 purchased, sold, exchanged, bartered, or given away must be *identified by a unique, permanent*
- 5 and unalterable method of identification elosed metal seamless banded with a band identifying
- 6 which will identify the breeder by whom they were bred. Acceptable methods include, but are not
- 7 limited to, uniquely numbered and sequenced leg bands, microchips, and tattoos.
- 8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
