It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 28-27 of the General Laws entitled "Mechanical Trades" is hereby
- 2 amended by adding thereto the following section:
  - 28-27-6.3. Purchase and sale restriction of refrigerant.
- 4 (a) No person may sell, distribute, offer for sale or purchase any ozone depleting substance
- 5 listed in the EPA Clean Air Act Rule 40 C.F.R §82 Subpart A, Appendices A and B unless that
- 6 person presents a certificate proving that they are in compliance with the certification requirements
- 7 established in 40 C.F.R. §§ 82.150 161.

- 8 (b) The director of the department of labor and training shall have the responsibility to
- 9 <u>enforce the provisions of this section.</u>
- 10 (c) Any violation of this section shall result in a fine of not more than five hundred dollars
- 11 (\$500) for a first violation and not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) for any subsequent
- 12 violation within one year of the first violation.
- 13 (d) In determining the amount of any penalty imposed pursuant to subsection (c) of this
- 14 section, the director or designee shall consider:
- 15 (1) The size of the employer's business;
- 16 (2) The good faith of the employer;
- 17 <u>(3) The gravity of the violation;</u>
- 18 (4) The history of previous violations; and

- 1 (5) Whether or not the violation was an innocent mistake or willful.
- 2 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
