## JOINT RESOLUTION

TO APPROVE AND PUBLISH AND SUBMIT TO THE ELECTORS A PROPOSITION OF AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE (GENERAL ASSEMBLY)

RESOLVED, That a majority of all members elected to each house of the general 1 2 assembly voting therefore, the following amendment to the Constitution of the state be proposed to the qualified electors of the state in accordance with the provisions of Article XIV of the 3 Constitution for their approval and that it take place of Article XIV, Section 1 which is hereby 4 5 amended to read as follows: SECTION 1. Procedure for proposing and approving amendments. - The general 6 7 assembly may propose amendments to the Constitution of the state by a roll call vote of a 8 majority of the members elected to each house. Any amendment thus proposed in two 9 consecutive years shall be published in such manner as the general assembly shall direct, and submitted to the electors at the next general election as provided in the resolution of approval; 10 11 and, if then approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon, it shall become a part of the 12 Constitution. 13 RESOLVED, That this amendment shall take, in the Constitution of the state, the place of Article XIV, Section 1 of the Constitution; it is further 14 15 RESOLVED, That the said proposition of amendments shall be submitted to the electors for their approval or rejection at the next statewide general election. The voting places in the 16 several cities and towns shall be kept open during the hours required by law for voting therein for 17

RESOLVED, That the secretary of state shall cause the said proposition of amendments

to be published as a part of this resolution in the newspapers of the state prior to the date of the said meetings of the said electors; and the said proposition shall be inserted in the warrants or notices to be issued previous to said meetings of the electors for the purpose of warning the town, ward, or district meetings, and said proposition shall be read by the town, ward, and district meetings to be held as aforesaid; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the town, ward, and district meetings to be held aforesaid shall be warned, and the list of voters shall be canvassed and made up, and the said, town, ward, and district meetings shall be conducted in the same manner as now provided by law for the town, ward, and district meetings for the election of general officers of the state.
