It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 42-72.1 of the General Laws entitled "Licensing and Monitoring of
- 2 Child Care Providers and Child-Placing Agencies" is hereby amended by adding thereto the
- 3 following section:
- 4 <u>42-72.1-9. Rebate of licensing fees.</u> In the following circumstances there shall be a
- 5 prorated rebate of licensing fees according to chapter 42-72.1-5 for daycare centers:
- 6 (1) If the daycare center closes six (6) months after the licensing period begins the
- 7 <u>daycare center shall receive a fifty percent (50%) rebate;</u>
- 8 (2) If the daycare center prepaid the licensing fee prior to July 1 and closes prior to July
- 9 <u>1, the daycare center shall be reimbursed the entire prepaid fee; or</u>
- 10 (3) If the daycare center operates for part of the year after July 1 but closes prior to June
- 11 <u>30 of the following year, the rebate will be prorated for the time of the closing to June 30.</u>
- 12 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
