It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Title 31 of the General Laws entitled "MOTOR AND OTHER VEHICLES"
2	is hereby amended by adding thereto the following chapter:
3	<u>CHAPTER 54</u>
4	COLLECTION OF MOTOR VEHICLE VIOLATIONS' FINES
5	31-54-1. Collection of motor vehicle violations' fines.
6	Notwithstanding any general law, rule or regulation to the contrary, no fines and/or costs
7	assessed as a result of a motor vehicle violation(s) of title 31 may be collected against a responsible
8	motorist by the state, any municipality or a court, more than seven (7) years after the violation fine
9	and/or cost become final and unappealable.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
