It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 21-36-3 of the General Laws in Chapter 21-36 entitled "The Inter Agency Food & Nutrition Policy Advisory Council" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 21-36-3. Council composition. -- There shall be an inter-agency food and nutrition 3 4 policy advisory council which shall consist of three (3) seven (7) members: the director of health 5 or his or her designee; the director of environmental management or his or her designee; and the director of administration or his or her designee-; the director of the department of human services 6 7 or his or her designee; the director of the division of elderly affairs or his or her designee; the 8 director of the department of corrections or his or her designee; and the commissioner of 9 elementary and secondary education or his or her designee. The members of the commission shall 10 elect a chairperson from among themselves.
- 11 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
