RELATING TO CRIMINAL OFFENSES -- ASSAULTS

Introduced By: Senators McCaffrey, Goodwin, and Ruggerio

Date Introduced: March 04, 2014

Referred To: Senate Judiciary

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 11-5 of the General Laws entitled "Assaults" is hereby amended by
2 adding thereto the following section:

3 **11-5-17. Assault or battery for purpose of causing unconsciousness. – Any person**
4 **who shall make an assault or battery, or both, by causing or attempting to cause another person to**
5 **be rendered unconscious by a single punch, kick or other singular striking motion to the head of**
6 **such person for the purpose of bringing about the loss of consciousness of such person, or who**
7 **shall knowingly assist, aid, abet, solicit, encourage, counsel, command, or conspire to coerce any**
8 **person to commit such an act, shall be deemed to have committed a felony, and shall be**
9 **imprisoned for not more than three (3) years, or fined not more than one thousand five hundred**
10 **dollars (\$1,500), or both.**

11 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION
BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
OF
A N A C T
RELATING TO CRIMINAL OFFENSES -- ASSAULTS

1 This act would provide that any person who shall commit an assault or battery for the
2 purpose of causing unconsciousness, a so-called "knockout assault," would be deemed to have
3 committed a felony, and would be imprisoned for not more than three (3) years, or fined not more
4 than one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500), or both.

5 This act would take effect upon passage.
