It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 27-18 of the General Laws entitled "Accident and Sickness 2 Insurance Policies" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section: 3 <u>27-18-71. Patient Wellness Promotion.</u> – No health insurance plan offered for sale in 4 Rhode Island shall require a patient co-payment for a routine preventative health care visit to the 5 patient's primary care physician. The director of the department of business regulation shall promulgate rules and regulations necessary to implement this section. 6 7 SECTION 2. Chapter 27-18.5 of the General Laws entitled "Individual Health Insurance Coverage" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section: 8 9 <u>27-18.5-10. Patient Wellness Promotion.</u> – No health insurance plan offered for sale in 10 Rhode Island shall require a patient co-payment for a routine preventative health care visit to the 11 patient's primary care physician. The director of the department of business regulation shall 12 promulgate rules and regulations necessary to implement this section. 13 SECTION 3. Chapter 27-19 of the General Laws entitled "Nonprofit Hospital Service 14 Corporations" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section: 15 27-19-62. Patient Wellness Promotion. – No health insurance plan offered for sale in Rhode Island shall require a patient co-payment for a routine preventative health care visit to the 16

10	patient's primary care physician. The director of the department of business regulation shall
11	promulgate rules and regulations necessary to implement this section.
12	SECTION 6. This act shall take effect upon passage.
