The candidates were then reviewed by an 7 independent panel that selected the State Honorees and Distinguished Finalists based on criteria 8 9 including personal initiative, effort, impact, and personal growth; and 10 WHEREAS, Robbie Thorp achieved national recognition for his exemplary volunteer service by being selected as one of the distinguished finalists for the 2016 Prudential Spirit of 11 12 Community Awards; and 13 WHEREAS, The recipients of this award clearly demonstrate that young people across 14 America are making remarkable contributions to the health and vitality of their communities and 15 deserve all the praise and appreciation that we can give them; and WHEREAS, Robbie has earned myriad honors for his advocacy and efforts to raise 16 17 awareness for epilepsy. He has been honored by Governor Raimondo, former Governor Chafee, 18 and Congressman Cicilline, and was chosen to be a Teen Advocate representing Rhode Island

with the Epilepsy Foundation of New England, and together with his mom, was also honored at
