It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 31-23 of the General Laws entitled "Equipment and Accessories
- 2 Generally" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>31-23-12.1. Providence canteen vehicles.</u>
- 4 (a) The motor vehicle equipment belonging to the Providence Canteen with headquarters
- 5 in Providence, Rhode Island, is declared to be an authorized emergency vehicle and may be
- 6 equipped with a siren, whistle or bell as provided in § 31-23-11.
- 7 (b) Any operator of the Providence Canteen motor vehicle shall have, at a minimum, five
- 8 (5) hours of training and instruction from an active or retired police officer or firefighter, in the
- 9 operation of the Providence Canteen vehicle as an authorized emergency vehicle and the use of
- 10 <u>emergency lights and sirens.</u>
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
