1 SECTION 1. Section 16-48.1-4 of the General Laws in Chapter 16-48.1 entitled

"Certification of Personnel Providing Educational Services to Very Young Children" is hereby

amended to read as follows:

<u>16-48.1-4. Criminal records checks -- Operations. -- (a)</u> Any person seeking to operate

a facility covered under section 16-48-1 shall apply to the bureau of criminal identification of the

state police or the local police department for a nationwide criminal records check. The check

7 will conform to the applicable federal standards including the taking of fingerprints to identify the

applicant. The commissioner will determine by rule those items of information appearing on a

criminal records check which constitute disqualifying information because the information would

10 indicate that the operation or, in the case of an employee, the employment could endanger the

health or welfare of a child or children. Upon the discovery of any disqualifying information with

respect to a proposed operator, the bureau of criminal identification of the state police or the local

13 police department will inform the commissioner in writing of the nature of the disqualifying

14 information.

(b) Notwithstanding any provision of the general or public laws to the contrary, the town

of Warren is hereby authorized to charge a reasonable fee for performing criminal record checks 16

as required by this chapter.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
