# RELATING TO MOTOR AND OTHER VEHICLES -- PASSING, USE OF LANES, AND RULES OF THE ROAD

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 31-15 of the General Laws entitled "Passing, Use of Lanes, and

Rules of the Road" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

3 31-15-9.1. One-way highways --school zones. – (a) Pursuant to the provisions of section

4 31-12-12, local authorities may designate particular highways as one-way highways, and require

5 that all vehicles travelling upon them be moving in one specific direction. This includes roadways

6 in school zones.

7 (b) No vehicle shall be operated upon a roadway in a school zone that is specifically

designated and sign posted for one-way traffic during certain designated times or hours of the day

9 or on a permanent basis.

10 (c) Violations of this section are subject to fines enumerated in 31-41.1-4.

SECTION 2. Section 31-41.1-4 of the General Laws in Chapter 31-41.1 entitled

12 "Adjudication of Traffic Offenses" is hereby amended to read as follows:

13 <u>31-41.1-4. Schedule of violations. -</u> (a) The penalties for violations of the enumerated

sections, listed in numerical order, correspond to the fines described. However, those offenses for

which punishments which may vary according to the severity of the offense, or punishment which

require the violator to perform a service, shall be heard and decided by the traffic tribunal or

municipal court. The following violations may be handled administratively through the method

18 prescribed in this chapter. This list is not exclusive and jurisdiction may be conferred on the

1 traffic tribunal with regard to other violations.

(1) For speeds up to and including ten miles per hour (10 mph) over the posted speed
limit on public highways, a fine as provided for in subsection (a) of this section for the first
offense, ten dollars (\$10.00) per mile for each mile in excess of the speed limit for the second
offense if within twelve (12) months of the first offense, and fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per mile for
each mile in excess of the speed limit for the third and any subsequent offense if within twelve
(12) months of the first offense. In addition, the license may be suspended up to thirty (30) days.

- (2) For speeds in excess of ten miles per hour (10 mph) over the posted speed limit on public highways, a mandatory fine of ten dollars (\$10.00) for each mile over the speed limit for the first offense, fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per mile for each mile in excess of the speed limit for the second offense if within twelve (12) months of the first offense, and twenty dollars (\$20.00) per mile for each mile in excess of the speed limit for the third and subsequent offense if within twelve (12) months of the first offense. In addition, the license may be suspended up to sixty (60) days.
- (c) Any person charged with a violation who pays the fine administratively pursuant to chapter 8.2 of title 8 shall not be subject to any additional costs or assessments, including, but not limited to, the hearing fee established in section 818-4 or assessment for substance abuse prevention.
