WHEREAS, The General Assembly enacted Chapter 12.4 of Title 42 entitled "The 1 2 Rhode Island Medicaid Reform Act of 2008"; and WHEREAS, A legislative enactment is required pursuant to Rhode Island General Laws 3 4 42-12.4-1, et seq.; and 5 WHEREAS, Rhode Island General Laws § 42-7.2-5(3)(i) provides that the Secretary of the Executive Office of Health and Human Services is responsible for the review and 6 7 coordination of any Medicaid section 1115 demonstration waiver requests and renewals as well 8 as any initiatives and proposals requiring amendments to the Medicaid state plan or category II or 9 III changes as described in the demonstration, "with potential to affect the scope, amount, or 10 duration of publicly-funded health care services, provider payments or reimbursements, or access 11 to or the availability of benefits and services provided by Rhode Island general and public laws"; 12 now therefore be it RESOLVED, In pursuit of an improved system of care, the legislature approves the 13 14 following proposal to amend the demonstration: 15 Implement a raise to provider reimbursement rates for immediate care facilities 16 consisting of residential facilities for persons with intellectual disabilities that are certified to 17 meet the requirements of 42 CFR 442, Subpart C, including certified community behavioral health centers (CCBHCs) by thirteen percent (13%) with the rates to be applied to managed care 18
