RELATING TO HEALTH AND SAFETY - VITAL RECORDS

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 23-3 of the General Laws entitled "Vital Records" is hereby
2	amended by adding thereto the following sections:
3	23-3-15.2. Access to original birth certificate by adopted person (a) An adopted
4	person, the adopted person's attorney or the descendants of the adopted person (if the adopted
5	person is deceased) may obtain an uncertified copy of that person's original certificate of birth
6	from vital statistics provided that the following requirements are met:
7	(1) The adopted person is at least eighteen (18) years of age and was born in Rhode
8	<u>Island.</u>
9	(2) The adopted person if alive, submits a written application and proper identification.
10	(3) The fee paid has been set at the same amount for an original birth certificate.
11	(b) The department of health shall develop an application form as required by this section
12	and may adopt other rules for the administration of this section.
13	23-3-15.3. Contact preference and medical history forms (a) Birth parents shall be
14	provided with a contact preference form on which a birth parent may state a preference regarding
15	contact by an adoptee. This form is subject to the utmost confidentiality. The birth parent may
16	choose one of the following three (3) options:
17	(1) "I would like to be contacted. I have completed the contact preference form and the
18	medical history form and I am filing them with the department of health - vital statistics."

(2) "I would prefer to be contacted only through an intermediary. I have completed this

1	contact preference form and a medical history form and I am filing them with the department of
2	health - vital statistics."
3	(3) "Do not contact me. I may change this preference by filling out another contact
4	preference form. I have completed this contact preference form and a medical history form and I
5	am filing them with the department of health - vital statistics."
6	(b) Birth parents shall be provided with a medical history form. This form shall describe
7	the medical history of the birth parent(s). This form is subject to the utmost confidentiality.
8	(c) After completion, the medical history form and contact preference form shall be
9	attached to the original birth certificate of the adoptee.
10	(d) The department of health - vital statistics office shall develop forms required by this
11	section.
12	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
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EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

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This act would allow adult adoptees or their representative access to their original birth certificate and possibly medical and contact information for the birth parents.
