RECOGNIZING THE LATE DONALD BOOTH FOR BEING AWARDED THE 2010 NEWPORT DAILY NEWS COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD

1	WHEREAS, The late Donald Booth of Newport was recently honored with a special
2	posthumous 2010 Newport Daily News Community Service Award; and
3	WHEREAS, Donald served with honor and distinction in the United States Army in
4	Korea and attended Brown University and Cornell University, receiving a degree in Hotel
5	Management in 1953; and
6	WHEREAS, Donald was a well-known activist and was a founding and leading member
7	of Concerned Citizens Against Casino Gambling since its inception in 1977. He spoke numerous
8	times at the State House and in the U.S. Congress to keep casino gambling out of the City of
9	Newport, ensuring the issue remained in the limelight for over 35 years; and
10	WHEREAS, After the death of his brother Frank, Donald was instrumental in founding
11	Island Hospice and Church Community Housing and was heavily involved in activities and
12	functions at Emmanuel Church; and
13	WHEREAS, Father Gordon Stenning of Emmanuel Church eulogized Donald's ability to
14	"fan the flames of grass roots efforts" and likened Donald's life "to the fire which begins to burn,
15	blazed hot and bright, then dies down, but sends its sparks out from the embers"; and
16	WHEREAS, This award is a testament to Donald's commitment to helping others in need
17	and speaking out for justice. Donald's memory will live on in the works of the many people
18	whose lives he touched; now, therefore be it
