RELATING TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES -- RETAIL LIQUOR LICENSES

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 37 of the General Laws entitled "Retail Licenses" is hereby 2 amended by adding thereto the following section: 3-7-16.8. Class BV license. – Notwithstanding any provision of this title to the contrary, 3 4 the local licensing board of the town of Tiverton has the power to grant and may grant upon 5 request, a license for the retail sale of alcoholic beverages at 221 Main Road which was formally and most recently utilized as a restaurant. The license may be granted to the owner, lessee or to 6 7 another person, firm or corporation in possession of the aforesaid property. The class BV license 8 grants the following privileges: (1) The right to keep for sale and to sell beverages at retail at the place described in the 9 10 license and to deliver those beverages for consumption on the premises. 11 (2) The annual fee for the license is the same as a class B license in the town and is 12 payable to the town where the licensed premises are located.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
