It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 23-17.7.1-15 of the General Laws in Chapter 23-17.7.1 entitled  
2 "Licensing of Nursing Service Agencies" is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 **23-17.7.1-15. Nursing service agencies exempt.**

4 The provisions of this chapter shall not apply to:

5 (1) Nursing service agencies and nursing exempt from regulation by the state; [or](#)

6 (2) Visiting nursing services or home health services conducted by and for those who rely  
7 exclusively upon spiritual means through prayer alone in accordance with the creed or tenets of a  
8 recognized church or religious denomination; ~~or~~

9 ~~(3) Nursing service agencies who limit the provision of temporary staff, including~~  
10 ~~registered nurses, licensed practical nurses, or nursing assistants, to one or more hospitals provided~~  
11 ~~that such nursing service agency maintain certification from the joint commission on the~~  
12 ~~accreditation of health care organizations or such other accreditation entity acceptable to the~~  
13 ~~director.~~

14 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
