It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 23-28.01 of the General Laws entitled "Comprehensive Fire Safety
- 2 Act" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>23-28.01-7. Forest plan for fire mitigation.</u>
- 4 An entity that owns five hundred (500) acres or more of land within the state shall have a
- 5 forest plan with a fire mitigation component. The entity shall submit the plan to the local fire
- 6 <u>department and the department of environmental management for approval.</u>
- 7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
