It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 32-1-17 in Chapter 32-1 of the General Laws entitled "General

2 Provisions" is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 <u>32-1-17. Persons with disabilities.</u> – (a) No fee shall be charged to any person with a

disability regardless of age, or to automobiles transporting a non-driver with a disability at any

recreational facility owned and operated by the state, provided, however, proper identification is

6 presented as prescribed by the department of environmental management. For the purpose of this

section "person with a disability" shall mean an individual who has a physical or mental

9 (1) (a) Social security disability benefits (SSDI),

10 (2) (b) Supplemental security income benefits (SSI), or

11 (3) (e) Veterans benefits and who shall be determined under applicable federal law by

the federal department of veterans' affairs to be one hundred percent (100%) disabled through a

13 service-connected disability.

14 For purpose of this section "fees" shall include all fees for parking, admittance, or other

user-fees for playing golf. The term "fees" shall not include licensing fees; camping fees, picnic

16 table fees or specialized facility use fees, including, but not limited to, fees for the use of

equestrian areas, performing arts centers, game fields and mule shed.
