SENATE RESOLUTION

CONGRATULATING DEPUTY CHIEF JOHN CARNEY FOR BEING NAMED A RICHMOND GRANGE #6 2010 COMMUNITY SERVICE "FIREFIGHTER OF THE YEAR"

WHEREAS, We have learned that the Richmond Grange #6 is honoring firefighters of
 the Union Fire District as their 2010 Firefighters of the Year; and

WHEREAS, The Union Fire District was established in the town of South Kingstown during 1883 to provide fire emergency service, fire prevention programs, and fire code enforcement to the majority of the town. Currently, there are eight fire stations in South Kingstown: Peace Dale, Wakefield, Tower Hill, Forestry, Snug Harbor, Matunuck, Tuckertown, and West Kingston; and

8 WHEREAS, The Union Fire District is made up of volunteer firefighters, and the 9 volunteers meet weekly for drills and training in their stations. The District has a state-of-the-art 10 training facility in Wakefield, which is used not only for volunteer training, but also for events 11 hosted by many other paid and volunteer departments within the State of Rhode Island; and

WHEREAS, While the Union Fire District may be made up of volunteers, these community members are always on hand to assist with whatever fire emergency there may be. During the historic flooding in March 2010, the Union Fire Districts' volunteer firefighters logged a total of more than 2,500 hours. They received approximately 75 emergency calls during and after the storm. These emergency calls included water rescues, box alarms, and fires. They also assisted flooded residents by pumping out 300 basements; and

18 WHEREAS, During this disaster in our state, these volunteer firefighters took time away19 from their families and homes to provide assistance and protection to their community. Many of

the volunteer firefighters took shifts and/or stayed at the local fire stations to answer any emergency calls. This dedication to their community is something that all of the residents of South Kingstown can be proud of; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That this Senate of the State of Rhode Island and Providence Plantations
hereby congratulates Deputy Chief John Carney on being named a Richmond Grange #6 2010
Community Service Firefighter of the Year and wish him many years of health and prosperity;
