It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 28-9.1-7 of the General Laws in Chapter 28-9.1 entitled 2 "Firefighters' Arbitration" is hereby amended to read as follows: <u>28-9.1-7. Unresolved issues submitted to arbitration.</u> – (a) In the event that the 3 4 bargaining agent and the corporate authorities are unable, within thirty (30) days from and 5 including the date of their first meeting, to reach an agreement on a contract, any and all unresolved issues shall be submitted to arbitration. 6 7 (b) Notwithstanding the term limitations to collective bargaining agreements contained in this chapter, the arbitration board may, with the agreement of the parties, render a decision that 8 9 brings the bargaining agreement up to date, regardless of the amount of years in question. 10 SECTION 2. Section 28-9.2-7 of the General Laws in Chapter 28-9.2 entitled "Municipal 11 Police Arbitration" is hereby amended to read as follows: 12 <u>28-9.2-7. Unresolved issues submitted to arbitration.</u> – (a) In the event that the 13 bargaining agent and the corporate authorities are unable, within thirty (30) days from and including the date of their first meeting, to reach an agreement on a contract, any and all 14 15 unresolved issues shall be submitted to arbitration. 16 (b) Notwithstanding the term limitations to collective bargaining agreements contained in

this chapter, the arbitration board may, with the agreement of the parties, render a decision that

brings the bargaining agreement up to date, regardless of the amount of years in question.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage.
