It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The provisions of section 42-61.2-7 of the general laws, in chapter 42-61.2

2 entitled "Video Lottery Terminal" which relates to an increased share of net terminal income for

- 3 the town of Lincoln and the city of Newport which are set to expire on June 30, 2010 are hereby
- 4 extended until June 30, 2011.
- 5 SECTION 2. Section 2 of chapter 218 of the public laws of 2009 entitled "An Act

Relating to State Affairs and Government – Video Lottery Terminal" is hereby amended to read
as follows:

8 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage and shall be retroactive to June 30,

9 2009 and it shall expire on June 30, 2010 <u>2011</u>.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE AFFAIRS AND GOVERNMENT - VIDEO LOTTERY TERMINAL

1 This act would extend the sunset date provided for in chapter 218 of the public laws of 2 2009 which increased the allocation of net terminal income to the town of Lincoln and the city of 3 Newport from June 30, 2010 to June 30, 2011. The allocation to the city of Newport increased 4 from one and one hundredth percent (1.01%) of net terminal income of authorized machines at 5 Newport Grand to one and two tenths percent (1.2%) of net terminal income of authorized 6 machines at Newport Grand for each week the facility operates video lottery games on a twenty-7 four (24) hour basis for all eligible hours authorized and to the town of Lincoln the allocation 8 increased from one and twenty-six hundredths percent (1.26%) of net terminal income of 9 authorized machines at Lincoln Park to one and forty-five hundredths percent (1.45%) of net 10 terminal income of authorized machines at Lincoln Park for each week the facility operates video 11 lottery games on a twenty-four (24) hour basis for all eligible hours authorized.

12 This act would take effect upon passage.
