It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 21-28 of the General Laws entitled "Uniform Controlled
 Substances Act" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>21-28-4.07.2.</u> Distribution to individuals without knowledge Crime of violence. --
- 4 (a) Definitions: For the purposes of this section the following words shall have the
- 5 <u>following definitions:</u>
- 6 (1) "Crime of violence" means:
- 7 (i) An offense that has an element, the use, attempted use, or threatened use of physical
- 8 force against the person or property of another; or
- 9 (ii) Any other offense that is a felony and that, by its nature, involves a substantial risk
- 10 that physical force against the person or property of another may be used in the course of
- 11 <u>committing the offense.</u>
- 12 (2) "Without that individual's knowledge" means: that the individual is unaware that a

13 substance with the ability to alter that individual's ability to appraise conduct, or to decline

- 14 participation in, or communicate unwillingness to participate in conduct, is administered to the
- 15 <u>individual.</u>
- 16 (b) Whoever, with the intent to commit a crime of violence against an individual, as
- 17 defined in this section and in chapter 11-37, violates this section by distributing a controlled
- 18 substance, as defined in section 21-28-1.02, or a controlled substance analogue to an individual
- 19 without that individual's knowledge, shall be punished by a term of imprisonment not to exceed

1 <u>ten (10) years.</u>

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

1 This act would provide for up to ten (10) years in prison for persons convicted of 2 distributing a controlled substance to someone without their knowledge with the intent to commit

3 a crime of violence against that other person.
