- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise the definition of the index factor in the state aid
- 2 to education formula to include a minimum annual percentage increase of two percent.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That subdivision (3) of § 13-13-10.1 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 (3) "Index factor," is the annual percentage change in the consumer price index for urban
 6 wage earners and clerical workers as computed by the Bureau of Labor Statistics of
 7 the United States Department of Labor for the year before the year immediately
 8 preceding the year of adjustment or three percent, whichever is less, except that it
