- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to extend dram shop protection to certain alcoholic
- 2 beverage licensees.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 35-4-78 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 35-4-78. No licensee may sell any alcoholic beverage:
- 6 (1) To any person under the age of twenty-one years; or
- 7 (2) To any person who is obviously intoxicated at the time.
- 8 A violation of this section is a Class 1 misdemeanor.
- 9 However, no licensee is civilly liable to any injured person or his the injured person's estate
- 10 for any injury suffered, including any action for wrongful death, or property damage suffered
- because of the intoxication of any person due to the sale of any alcoholic beverage in violation
- of the provisions of this section or because of the consumption of alcoholic beverages by an
- employee due to the negligent supervision of that employee by the licensee or the licensee's
- 14 employees.
