- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

- 5 Section 2. That § 2-16-15 be amended to read as follows:
- 6 2-16-15. No provision of the code enacted by § 2-16-13, as to which any action or
- 7 proceeding, civil or criminal, has been commenced prior to July 1, <del>2009</del> <u>2010</u>, to determine
- 8 whether or not such provision was constitutionally enacted, is validated by the enactment of this
- 9 code.
- The enactment of the code:
- 11 (1) Does not affect the validity of any transaction;
- 12 (2) Does not impair the curative or legalizing effect of any statute; and
- 13 (3) Does not release or extinguish any penalty, confiscation, forfeiture, or liability; which
- accrued, occurred, or took effect prior to the time the code took effect.
- 15 Section 3. That § 2-16-16 be amended to read as follows:
- 2-16-16. All statutes, other than this code, enacted at the <del>2009</del> 2010 session of the
- 17 Legislature shall be deemed to have been enacted subsequently to the enactment of this code.
- 18 If any such statute repeals, amends, contravenes, or is inconsistent with the provisions of this
- code, the provisions of the statute shall prevail. Any enactment in the  $\frac{2009}{2010}$  2010 session of the
- 20 Legislature which cites South Dakota Codified Laws for the purpose of amendment or repeal,
- shall be construed as having reference to the code enacted by § 2-16-13.
