| 6 | 10-6-33.31. Before July first each year, the secretary of revenue and regulation shall | |
| 7 | annually provide each director of equalization the agricultural income value for each county as | |
| 8 | computed pursuant to § 10-6-33.28. The director of equalization shall annually determine the | |
| 9 | assessed value of agricultural land. The assessed value of agricultural land may be adjusted by | |
| 10 | the following factors: | |
| 11 | (1) | The capacity of the land to produce agricultural products as defined in § 10-6-33.2; |

| 13 | (2) | The location, size, soil survey statistics, terrain, and topographical condition of the |
| 14 | | land including the climate, accessibility, and surface obstructions which can be |

- Each adjustment shall be documented. The director of equalization may document an
- 3 adjustment by using data from sources reasonably related to the adjustment being made. In
- 4 addition, the director of equalization may use data from comparable sales of agricultural land
- 5 to document the adjustment for any of the factors listed in this section.
