- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions regarding the authorization to
- 2 provide postsecondary education.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 13-48-37 be amended to read:
- 5 13-48-37. The secretary shall issue a certificate of authorization to provide postsecondary
- 6 education to any postsecondary institution named in § 13-48-36. The secretary also may issue
- 7 a certificate of authorization to provide postsecondary education to any other postsecondary
- 8 institution to provide educational education programs at physical locations in this state if the to
- 9 <u>any postsecondary institution that:</u>
- 10 (1) Is established as an instrumentality of this state or another state, or is legally
- 11 established to operate as a private business entity or nonprofit corporation in
- 12 accordance with applicable state law is duly organized and existing as a corporation
- 13 <u>or other entity under the laws of this state, or is qualified to conduct business as a</u>
- 14 <u>foreign entity in this state;</u> and
- 15 (2) Is accredited or is operating under an affiliation agreement whose terms make an

2		educational credentials to its students and maintaining transcripts for such students;

4	<u>(3)</u>	Has filed with the secretary an application for certificate of authorization, on a form	
5		prescribed by the secretary, and paid an initial nonrefundable application fee of five	
6		hundred dollars.

11	institutio	n continues to meet the requirements set forth in § in subdivisions 13-48-37(1) and (2)	
12	and has not been ordered to cease operations in the state pursuant to § 13-48-40.		
13	Section 3. That chapter 13-48 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:		
14	Exce	pt as provided in section § 13-48-38, each certificate of authorization expires on the	
15	first day of July following the date of issue. The secretary shall annually renew the certificate		
16	of any postsecondary institution that:		
17	(1)	Continues to meet the requirements in subdivisions 13-48-37(1) and (2);	
18	(2)	Has not been ordered to cease operations in the state pursuant to § 13-48-40; and	
19	(3)	Has filed with the secretary on or before the first day of July of each year an	
20		application for renewal, on a form prescribed by the secretary, and paid a renewal fee	
21		of two hundred fifty dollars.	
22	Section 4. That chapter 13-48 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:		
23	The secretary may reinstate an expired certificate of authorization if the postsecondary		
24	institution:		

1	(1)	Continues to meet the requirements of subdivisions 13-48-37(1) and (2);

- 2 (2) Has not been ordered to cease its operations in the state pursuant to § 13-48-40; and
- 3 (3) Has filed with the secretary an application for reinstatement, on a form prescribed by
- 4 the secretary, and paid a nonrefundable reinstatement fee of two hundred fifty dollars.
