HOUSE BILL NO. 1038

Introduced by: The Committee on Appropriations at the request of the Department of Public Safety

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to authorize the Department of Public Safety to build a
2 highway patrol office and motorcycle training facility in Rapid City, to make an
3 appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

5 Section 1. The Department of Public Safety may contract for the construction, completion,
6 furnishing, equipping, and maintaining of, including heating, plumbing, water, sewer, electric
7 facilities, associated parking lot and sidewalk, architectural and engineering services, and such
8 other services or actions as may be required to construct a highway patrol office and motorcycle
9 training building comprising approximately five thousand square feet, to be located on the
10 Department of Transportation's Rapid City campus or in the immediate vicinity, in Rapid City,
11 South Dakota.

12 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of one million four
13 hundred thousand dollars (\$1,400,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, and the sum
14 of three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) in other fund expenditure authority, or so much
15 thereof as may be necessary, to the Department of Public Safety to construct the facilities



1 described in section 1 of this Act.

2 Section 3. The Bureau of Administration, pursuant to chapter 5-14, shall supervise the
3 design and construction of this project. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety shall
4 approve vouchers and the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by
5 this Act.

6 Section 4. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated shall
7 revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.

8 Section 5. Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its
9 existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in
10 full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
